- June meeting minutes approved
- Brookside mowing concerns:

Damaged stones in Brookside noted during 2015 mowing season (photos reviewed) in future be sure to emphasis care when mowing-extensive stone damage may result in termination of contract and/or penalty as determined by cemetery commission in discussion with selectboard

- **Restoration** Another portion of Brookside completed & stone in Cloverdale repaired Glenn concerned about the effect cleaning has on readibility.
- Cedar Tree decided to take down the 2 cedar trees in the back one is looking poorly & 2nd one better to take it down at the same time
  - Will obtain bids & budget for \$ 3,000.00 & plan on taking it down sometime during fiscal year 2016-17
- **Veteran marker** there is a broken marker for a Civil War soldier-Lynn to plan on working with Mansfield monuments to apply for a replacement marker from the Veterans Administration
- Future restoration on hold until we obtain a bid for the removal of the 2 trees in Brookside Cemetery. If money left in our upcoming fiscal year budget we will do a portion of Brookside
- Cookyard-will attempt later this month or November to cut some of the brush..Ron will contact the adjacent landowner. He also has a truck & can dispose of the brush.
- Brookside Glenn suggested to in the future have 3-4 loads of fill at the south end of the cemetery
- Budget Last year Cemetery Commission (including Richardson) was \$ 5,200 & Brookside was \$2,200.00. Total= \$ \$ 7.400. Because of the 2 cedar trees in Brookside it was voted to ask for a total of \$ 9,400, willing to settle for \$ 8.400. Will present our proposal during budget discussion with the Town Selectboard
- **Town Report** End of fiscal year. Lynn will do and send a draft to Glenn & Ron for suggestions before submitting for publication in the Town Report
