

network system, the town garage does not have a firewall to protect the computer beyond the anti-virus software on the computer. Not all viruses are detected by anti-virus software but would be stopped by a firewall.

The Selectboard decided that because the town garage computer does not need the same protection as the computers at the town office, the bundle is not necessary.

ROAD SCHEDULE

Allison Hope made a motion to approve the December 12, 2017 through December 28, 2017 Road Schedule, seconded by Casey Mathieu. Motion passed: 2-0.

FY'19 DRAFT BUDGET

The Board reviewed the admin and highway draft budgets.

John advised that a used wood chipper is approximately \$20,000. He would like to use the \$20,000 in the FY'18 budget for a down payment for the chipper.

Based on changes made to the budget at this meeting, the amount to be raised by taxes will increase approximately 9%. Greg and Nanette will review the budget and factor in the Grand List and other items to firm up the numbers for the informational meeting being held on January 11th.

ACCOUNTS PAYABLE & PAYROLL WARRANTS

The Board approved the accounts payable and payroll warrants.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Town's attorney advised that per the Class 4 Road Ordinance, the Town is obligated to maintain and plow a portion of Dick Lavalley's driveway, which is classified as a Class 4 Road. However, the Town does not need to maintain and plow the Class 4 portion of Dick's driveway to the same level as other Class 4A roads that have more than one resident.
