

Challenges

Boards of Civil Authority are required to meet bi-annually before September 15 to review the checklist and identify voters who no longer live in town and have not already had their voting status in Westford challenged. The Town Clerk provided the BCA with a list of voters known to have moved and some that may no longer live in town. It was noted that just because a voter receives a challenge letter, it does not mean they cannot vote in Westford. However, they will have to sign an affidavit stating they still reside in town before they will be allowed to vote.
