## ON-SITE SURVEY AND DATA COLLECTION CONSENT FORM

The undersigned hereby grants permission to the Town of Westford's officers, employees, and specified engineer to enter upon the premises of 1705 Vermont Route 128, Westford, VT for the purpose of completing topographic, zoning, and environmental surveys, and soil and groundwater testing. The access purpose is to conduct preliminary work incident to the potential design and permit of a wastewater treatment system at the subject property for the Town of Westford. No disturbance to the ground or vegetation shall occur for survey work and any minor disturbance from soil and groundwater investigations shall be promptly restored. All data collected shall be deemed confidential and shall remain in the custody and control of the Town of Westford and its agents until made public. After the data is made public, and if the Town of Westford and property owner do not proceed with a revised agreement, all data will be donated to the property owner. This agreement shall remain in effect for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of execution unless an extension is approved in writing by the property owner, or until the sale of the property, whichever occurs first.
