**Mission Statement**

To identify and investigate alternatives to the Maple Shade community wastewater system, and to provide periodic reports to the Selectboard for consideration.

**Background and Objectives**

The Selectboard voted on January 11, 2024, to explore wastewater alternatives to Maple Shade. This new committee, the Wastewater Alternatives Committee (WAC), was appointed by both the Town Selectboard and Planning Commission. All meetings are open to the public. The WAC will seek involvement from the public at each meeting.

“Wastewater”, for the purposes of this committee, is defined as a collection and treatment system(s) serving only the town office & library (municipal uses); municipal and civic buildings (public, non-profit); or any combination of private, municipal, and civic users.

**Membership and Officers**

Each member shall serve until the WAC’s work is deemed complete by the Selectboard. Because the committee is in a support role to the Town, there is no Chair or Vice-Chair. Instead, a Moderator will run the meeting and be the point of contact for the community. Public information will be posted on the Town’s website.
